

MUSEUMS REOPEN SAFELY



To ensure visitor's safety and reduce the risk of Covid-19 contagion, Ferrara is reopening the museums in stages, applying the prevention and social distancing measures recommended for public spaces and for a safe visit.



Each museum has a **maximum set number of persons** (visitors + museum staff) allowed to be present at the same time. **Admissions are scheduled in time slots** to avoid overcrowding.

We strongly recommend booking tickets in advance from Tuesday to Friday.

Booking a timed ticket in advance is required to enter our museums on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays: <http://prenotazionemusei.comune.fe.it>



Signs with all the essential information **about safety measures** have been placed around the museum to guide visitors.

We invite you to read and follow the rules below:



→ access to the museums is strictly prohibited if you have a body temperature higher than 37.5° C;



→ it is mandatory to wear a facemask for all visitors over 6 years age;



→ wash your hands often with the hydroalcoholic hand sanitizers that you will find through the visiting path;



→ during the visit, please maintain at least 1.5 metre distance between yourself and other visitors;



→ avoid contact with display cases and objects

More information:

- card payments are strongly recommended;
- we kindly ask you not to touch the merchandise in the bookshop; for any request, the museum staff is at your disposal;
- audioguides, if available, will be sanitized after every use;
- the cloakroom service will not be available, visitors are invited to carry only essential personal items and to avoid travel bags, backpacks or bulky bags;
- the use of the lift is reserved to people with mobility difficulties or disabilities; in case of need, the museum staff will provide guidance for the use
